Re: Archaeological Resources, Duntroon Cumulative Impact

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that there will not be any cumulative impact on archaeological resources as a result of the concurrent operation of the Duntroon and Osprey quarries. Archaeological resources are only impacted when previously undisturbed lands that have not been subjected to a formal archaeological assessment are disturbed by development activities. This is not the case in this situation. Both of the proposed quarries have already been subjected to Stage 1-2 archaeological assessments. Both of the assessments failed to identify any archaeological sites on the two properties. Consequently, the operation of both quarries at the same time will have no impact on archaeological resources.
